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**JOB SUMMARY:**

Responsibilities include:

- Working collaboratively with the leadership of Sojourn Chaplaincy and appropriate hospital staff to provide the provision of spiritual care services to patients, their loved ones, and staff.
- Serve as per diem clinical staff chaplain as needed, leading the delivery of spiritual support to the unique psychosocial and cultural needs of the patients, staff and families.
- Work closely with the Spiritual Care team and the staff of the hospital as well as the community to ensure the Spiritual Care needs of the patients are met.
- May require duties outside of normal responsibilities as disaster response effort requires.
- Provide limited Tele-Chaplaincy for patients and their family members as needed
- Perform related duties as required.

**EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:**

- Possession of a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university.
- Possession of a Master degree in theology, divinity, religious studies or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Completion of four units of Clinical Pastoral Education or equivalent experience.
- Board certification through the Association of Professional Chaplains or equivalent organization (or demonstrated eligibility for board certification) preferred.
- Demonstrated Chaplaincy and Spiritual Care Skills.
- Experience/familiarity with the unique needs of Chaplaincy in a crisis
- Experience/familiarity with Sojourn Chaplaincy.

**ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Possess strong coordination and organizational skills.

- Show initiative and use good judgment in decision-making and a strong sense of appropriate boundaries in chaplaincy.
- Maintain confidentiality as circumstances warrant.
- Ability to maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, co-workers, health professionals, volunteers, community clergy and the general public.
- Demonstrate strong communication skills, including computer literacy skills, and good interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work independently and self supervise
- Ability to work collaboratively as a member of a team
- Ability to take direction from leadership and execute that direction quickly and effectively in a disaster response effort.
- Position is Per Deim. This means that hours for the position are as needed. Ability to be flexible with hours is required for this position.
- Ability to communicate in English and other languages (Spanish, Cantonese, Tagalog, Russian) desired but not required for the position.
- Commitment to working in a hospital during a pandemic be an essential worker in a disaster response.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:**

This position may require moderately difficult manipulative tasks such as writing, sitting at a desk for periods of time, wearing PPE, walking/moving around a large wheelchair accessible hospital environment. Ability to attend meetings, sit and listen and use phone and computer is required.
